

US LNG Weekly Recap - Week of 02/27/2026

Weekly Highlights

Golden Pass: Approved to introduce hazardous fluids into the cold ends, signally the request for first LNG on Train 1 is imminent. Progress advanced on piping and structural steel for Trains 2 and 3. The latest inspection report stated the MP 01 compressor station connecting NGPL to the Golden Pass Pipeline expansion was mechanically complete, but access to the NGPL interconnect was precluded do to construction from another pipeline.

Corpus Christi ST3: Received approval to introduce feedgas into cold end of Train 5.

Louisiana LNG: For January, the facility had ongoing construction with the completion of pre-assembly of Tank 1 and Tank 2 roof panels and working on foundation preparations for LNG tanks 1 and 2. They planned to advance foundation work for Plants 1 and 2, and for LNG tank areas during February.

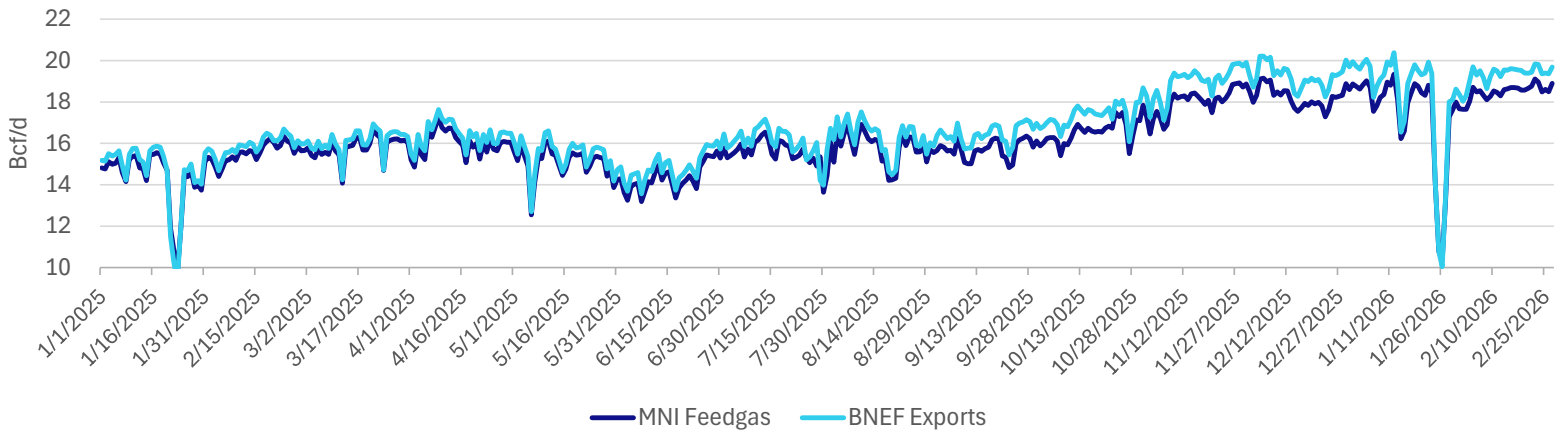
Port Arthur: Concrete pouring for foundations was nearly complete, aboveground piping is being installed for Trains 1 and 2, and the main cryogenic heat exchanger for Train 1 and the thermal oxidizer for Trains 1 and 2 were set. Inner wall construction of Tank A began, while site prep for phase 2 was beginning.

Commonwealth: Pre-construction activities included initial site mowing and work on the well casings. They expect mobilization of the EPC (mechanical construction) to begin in March.

Rio Grande: Received FERC approval to construct storage tanks 3 and 4.

CP2: Construction consists of initial site clearing and erosion control activities, signaling very early stages of construction. Activity for CP Express is ongoing, but the inspection report noted several areas of noncompliance.

Daily L48 LNG Feedgas Total



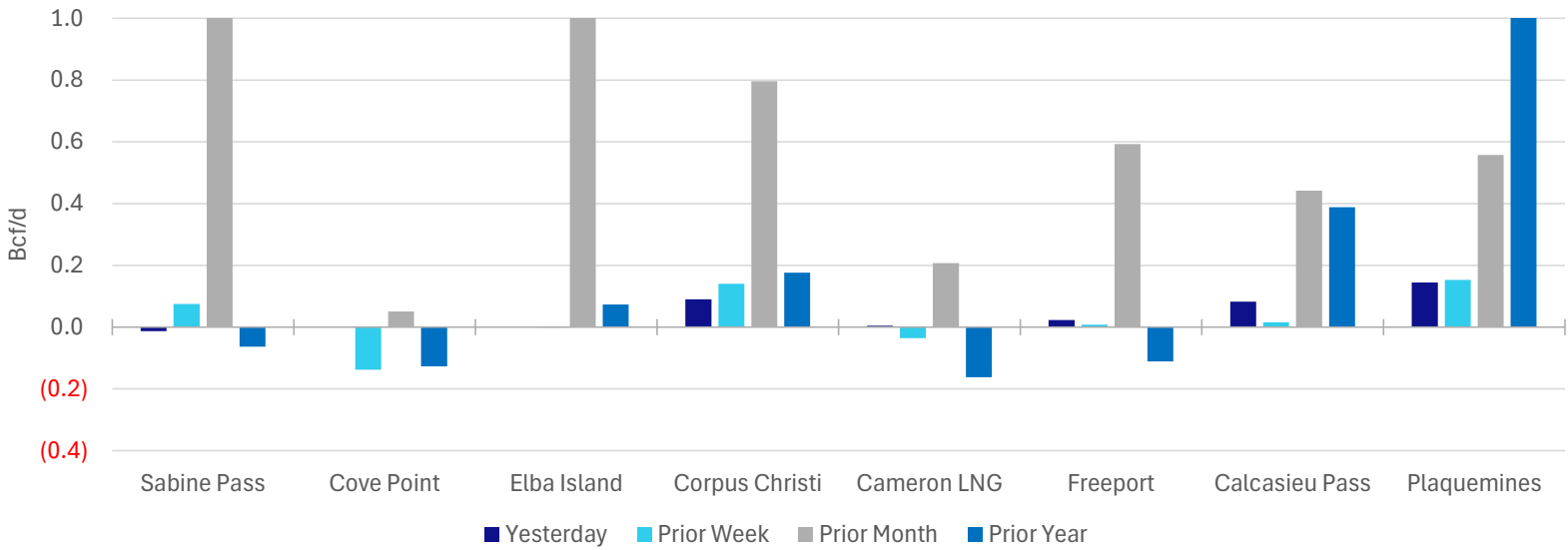

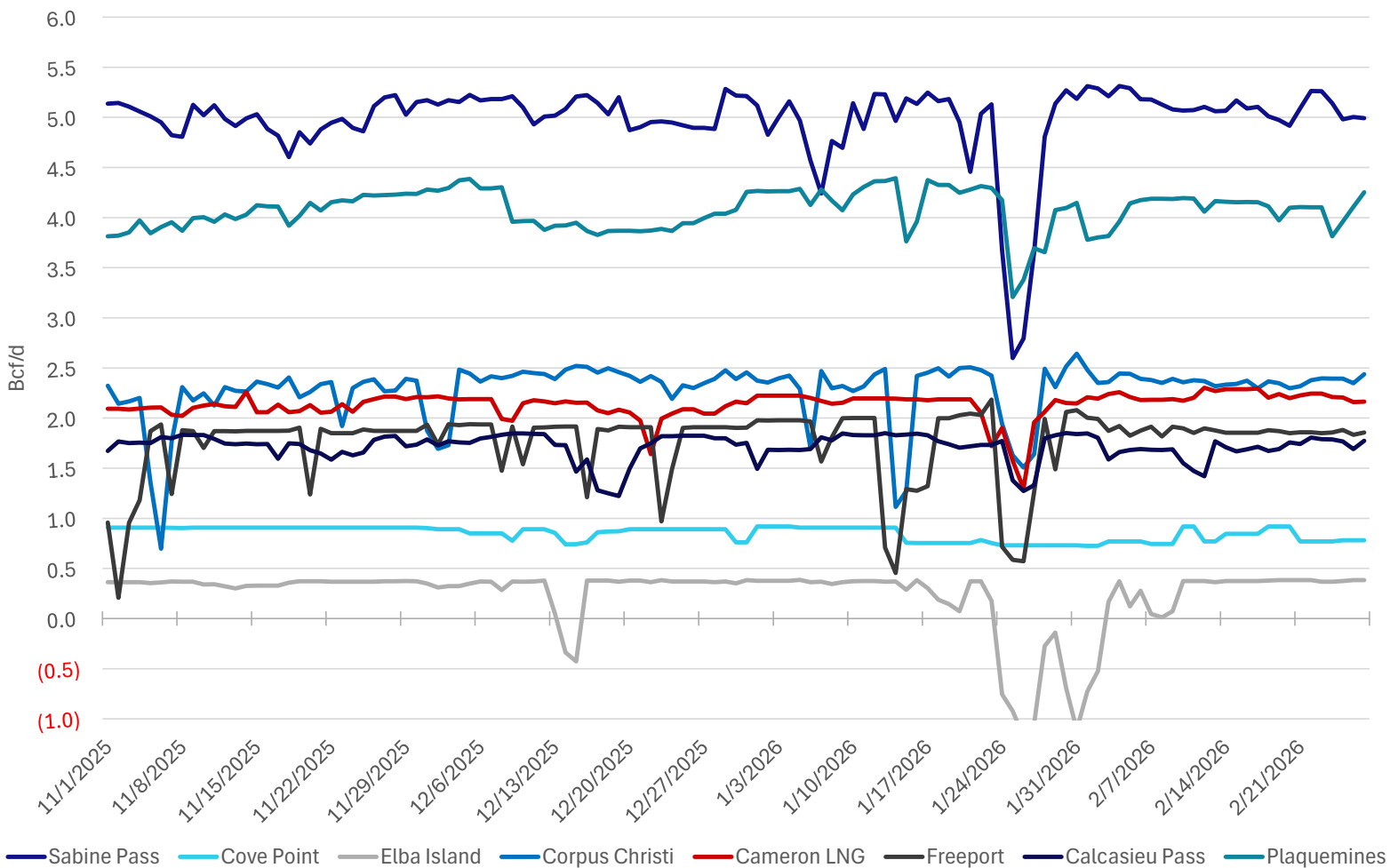

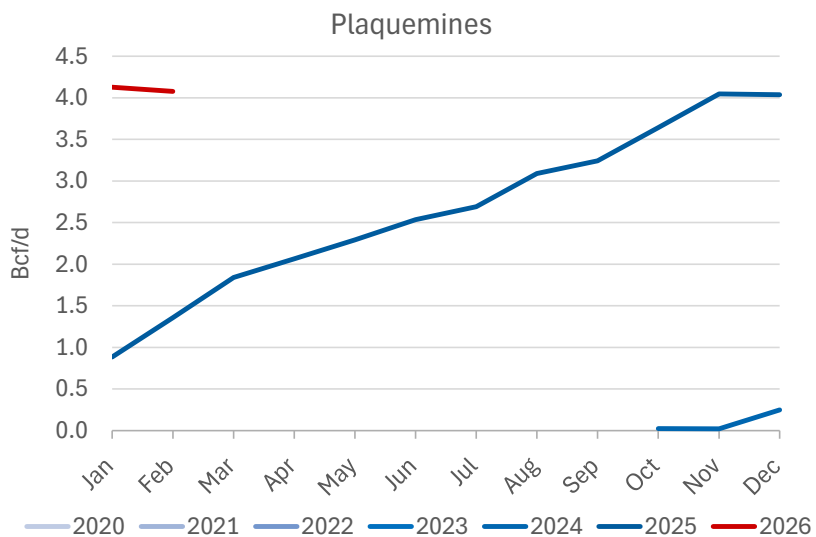
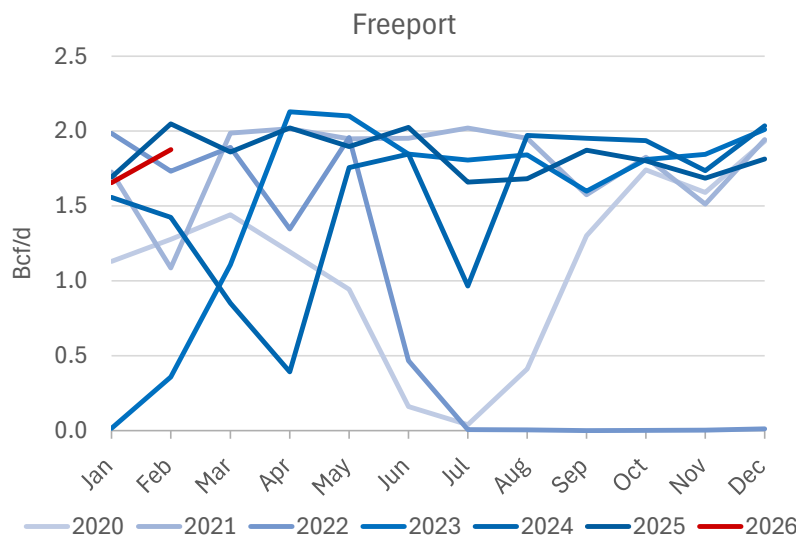

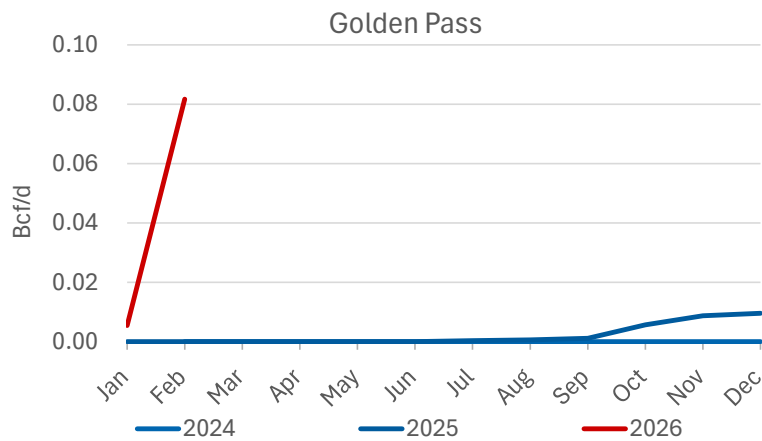
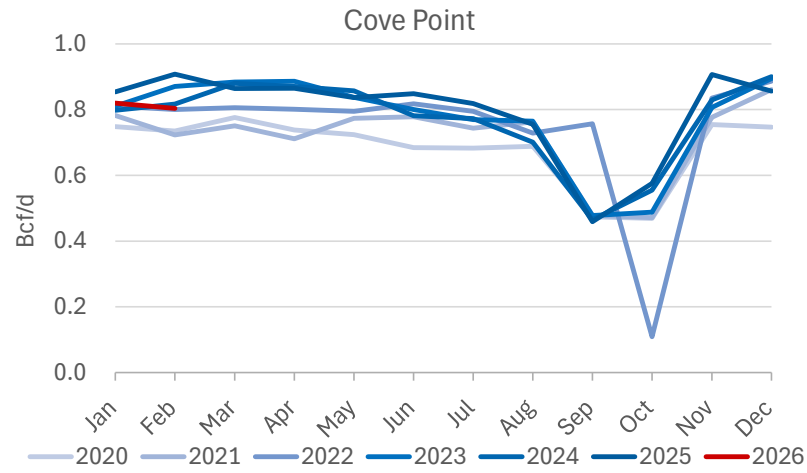
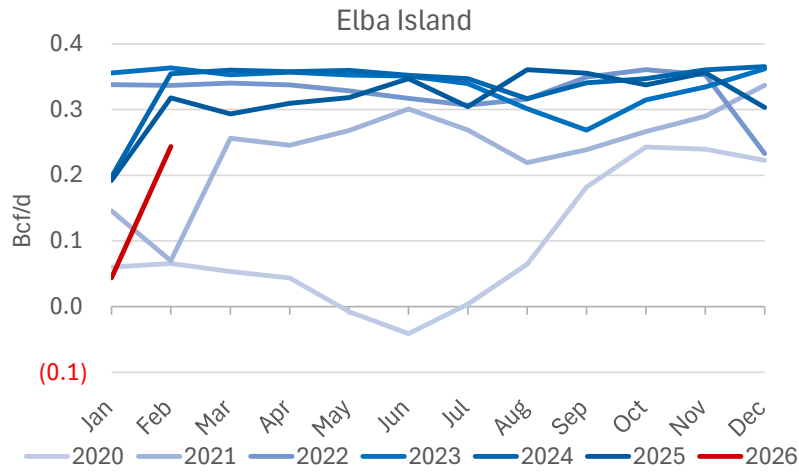
Daily LNG Feedgas Deliveries by Facility - Prior 3 Months
